## **How to Find an ISBN**

The ISBN is a 13 digit number that identifies a title by its publisher, edition and format. The most common place the ISBN can be found is on the back cover above the barcode.



The ISBN can be also found in the front copyright page. You will want to be sure you are providing the ISBN that matches the format of the title. For instance, a loose-leaf title will have the hardcover ISBN also listed in the copyright page.
